



- 3. Click on the blue dots for construction bulletins. Content will appear to the right of the map.







Marigold Infrastructure Partners Early Works

Marigold Infrastructure Partners is preparing for construction along the LRT route. Most of this work involves drilling boreholes to check the ground conditions, which helps the City and Marigold with detailed design work for the project. Lane and sidewalk closures are expected. Construction Notice: Valley Line West LRT Lane Closures on 170 Street and 87 Avenue

On or around **November 12, 2021**, Marigold Infrastructure Partners (MIP) will begin work to prepare the 170 Street and 87 Avenue intersection for the construction of the elevated guideway support. To accommodate this work, one northbound lane, and two southbound lanes on the north side of 87 Avenue and 170 Street intersection will be closed over the weekend of November 12 to November 15. These lanes will close from 7 p.m. Friday, November 12 and reopen at 6 a.m., Monday, November 15.

87 Avenue & 170 Street



Impacts to the Public:

- One northbound lane and two southbound lanes on 170 Street at 87 Avenue will be closed.
- Southbound to eastbound left turns on 170 Street at 87 Avenue will be maintained.
- Eastbound to northbound left turns at 87 Avenue to 170 Street will be maintained.
- Work will occur over the weekend from 7 p.m. Friday evening to 6 a.m. Monday morning.
- Pedestrian traffic will be detoured to the south side of 87 Avenue. Please observe and follow all maps and wayfinding signage posted in the area.
- There will be noise associated with this work. Every effort will be made to reduce the impact to the public.

Laydown Areas / Temp Offices


What: Secured storage area

Tree Removals

Where: Moving Work Zone along the alignment.

When: Started in September and majority of trees that need to be removed will be completed over the coming months.

Do not affix holiday lights or decorations to City of Edmonton trees along the alignment as it may be slated for removal.

Stakeholder Notice Upcoming Tree Removals Ahead of Valley Line West Construction

As the holiday season draws near, we appreciate that you may be preparing to decorate the trees adjacent to your business. However, to make room for the construction of Valley Line West, many of those trees are slated for removal.

In the coming months, Marigold Infrastructure Partners (MIP) will be removing ~1,200 trees on City of Edmonton property between Lewis Farms and Glenora (up to 138 Street) in preparation for Valley Line West LRT construction.

This work will occur during daytime hours (9 a.m. – 3 p.m.) and is expected to last two months. Crews will endeavour to work on the boulevards adjacent to the trees, however, temporary parking and traffic interruptions may occur. Further, pedestrian traffic may be detoured while the work occurs.

Marigold Infrastructure Partners makes every effort to preserve trees where possible, and to replace them at project completion if they must be removed.

Impacts to the Public:

- This will be a Moving Work Zone work will not be fixed to one location but will move from site-to-site along the alignment between Lewis Farms Transit Centre through to the <u>Glenora</u> area (Stony Plain Rd and 138 Street).
- Work will occur during off-peak hours (9 a.m. 3 p.m.)
- · This work is expected to last two months.
- There will be periodic traffic interruptions while this work occurs (15 minutes up to three hours at each location).
- · Pedestrian traffic may be detoured to the opposite side of the road.

What is the City's approach to tree removals for Valley Line West?

- Each tree affected has been assessed and recorded by the City and Marigold.
- Under the City of Edmonton policy, Marigold will be compensating the City for each tree being removed.
- There will be a full landscaping plan that will see plantings of ~1,800 new native trees and shrubs to areas along the alignment.
- Tree cutting will occur outside of the bird nesting season, so nesting migratory birds will not be disturbed.

What goes into the decision to remove trees?

- Is the tree of an age that the roots could damage infrastructure along the alignment?
- Will the location of the trees affect the operation of the train or be in the way of a noise attenuation wall or shared use path?
- · Will the trees be in the way of utility lines?
- What is the size of the tree? Larger trees will not survive any attempt at relocation.



What is the species of the tree? Sometimes cutting near the roots of a tree is enough to
cause it to fail.
